grandkids, to influence our friends to love God, to appreciate and acknowledge His creation, and to show that God is the giver of all good things. But none are more important than God and people. The things, the work, and the activities are simply tools used to exalt God and to serve the people God has privileged us to be around.

And we can simplify. Maybe we just have too much stuff. Some of our possessions might just possess us. Maybe our activities are taking too much of our precious time. Is any material thing or any activity taking a bigger place than God and the people He has placed in our lives? And we need to make room for something else that should take a place of priority in our lives; yes, make time for rest, reflection, and quiet. It's o.k.; your body, mind, and spirit need it.

You are a wonderful person, created by an Awesome God, dearly loved by Him and so many people. You are a gift to Him and to the world around you. Jesus made and arranged this summer with you in mind so that you could be busy about living and doing His good will to His glory.

Go ahead, be busy. Busy as a bee with all that is truly important.




T.E.A.M.s-
